RULES and REQUIREMENTS

- 1) FEES for Grand Pass Tour pin for your initial season: \$7 for solo rider, \$3 for co-rider (if mailed together)
- 2) FEES for Year bars for your successive seasons: \$5 for solo rider, \$2 for co-rider (if mailed together)
- 3) DATES: Any time during the current year (Jan. 1 to Dec. 31) riding season
- 4) REQUIREMENTS: Send photographs of your motorcycle in front of a minimum of seven (7) different Colorado pass signs (motorcycle and co-rider for two-up riding) from any seven of the passes from the list below. Please email us your pictures if you can to save paper and postage. You can then mail us your application and payment. However, if you would prefer to mail everything, please feel free to do so.
- 5) Please be aware that some of the passes either do not have a sign identifying the pass summit, or the area is not safe to pull off and take a photo. If this is the case, take a photo of something scenic nearby. We'll take your word for it. Once we have received your photos, completed registration form, and fees, we will send you your **GRAND PASS TOUR** pin. PLEASE NOTE: Photos will not be returned!
- 6) QUALIFYING PASSES: There are a total of 62 beautiful Colorado Rocky Mountain passes and roads on the **GRAND PASS TOUR**. See the list for more information.

The unpaved passes are included for those adventurous riders. All of these unpaved passes were previously ridden on a Gold Wing. However, it is advisable to check conditions locally before attempting to accomplish any pass, paved or unpaved. For example, passes could be temporarily closed due to rock slides or other conditions. If you encounter serious difficulty, please turn back and contact the tour sponsors so that adjustments can be made in the list of qualifying passes. Extra care should be taken when riding over any of the unpaved passes.

Although they are not truly mountain passes, we have included some particularly scenic and challenging roads on the list. Credit will be given for completing any of these rides just as if they were mountain passes.
